



A. Statute of Limitations (referred to as Prescription in Louisiana)

- **Personal injury:** 1 year from date of loss
- **Wrongful death:** 1 year from date of death

B. Comparative Fault

- Louisiana is a pure comparative fault state. Each party (whether involved or named in suit) will be assessed his or her proportionate share of fault and is liable for only those damages.
La. Civ. Cod article 2323

C. Joint and Several Liability

- See above regarding pure comparative fault.

D. Serious Injury Threshold

- None in Louisiana.

E. PIP Subrogation

- Louisiana does not have PIP coverage.
